- C. Other Matters
1. Workshop on Fundraising in Catholic Schools
The Archbishop reported that a workshop will be presented Friday, November 16 and Saturday, November 17 at the Catholic Center in the Sandia Room for pastors, principals and laity involved in fundraising in Catholic schools. The workshop will be presented by Sr. Katleen Collins from the NCEA.
 2. Center for Action and Contemplation
Archbishop Michael has written to Kathleen O'Malley, Director of The Center for Action and Contemplation expressing strong objections in regard to speakers and activities sponsored by the Center for Action and Contemplation, and serious concerns regarding their periodical, "Radical Grace" which has printed articles contrary to Catholic teaching, the most recent dealing with positions and criticisms of the Church's position on homosexuality.
 3. The Archbishop reported on the newly approved *The Basic Plan for Ongoing Formation of Priests*, which he will send out to all the priests of the Archdiocese as a gift.

- B. Development Committee Report
The chancellor met with Richard Garrigan in May to form a team of leaders consisting of laity, religious, and priests to look at long term planning. They will meet Monday, August 13 to discuss inviting more leaders, and to focus on the goals of the committee.
- C. Priestly Life and Ministry Committee: Stewardship Workshop
The workshop on stewardship will take place Wednesday September 5 in the Sandia Room. The workshop will be practical and experiential in scope, presented by priests of the Archdiocese who have been successful with stewardship.
- D. Priests Convocation
The chancellor met with Rev. Vince Chavez to discuss some of the details of the convocation to take place Las Vegas, NM November 5-7. The presenter will be Fr. Jim Moroney from the Bishop's Committee on the Liturgy on the New General Instruction of the Roman Missal. V. Chavez has suggested offering a tour of the Moctezuma World College which has been newly renovated, and has an important part in the history of the Archdiocese. The Council agreed that offering such a tour on Monday afternoon is a good idea.
- The Council discussed and agreed that the Convocation should continue to be a function of the Presbyteral Council, and the Priestly Life & Ministry Committee.
