Sunday, May 13– Saturday, May 19, 2001

Come and experience the border reality where political, social and economic inequities cannot be ignored. Participants will learn about immigration, NAFTA, poverty, and human rights issues from the families who are most profoundly affected by these issues on both sides of the border. Participants will spend 4 nights in the colonias of Juarez bearing witness as to how our "first-world" progress is effecting our not-so-distant neighbors. Time will also be spent in Albuquerque exploring the realities of the lives of immigrants within the U.S.

Cost \$575. This includes all costs: meals, housing, transportation and materials.

These teachings on the "mysteries" and the accompanying rituals of Pass-over have met with a very strong response in recent years. The result of Richard's research on male initiation will be presented for the *last time* this year. This is your last opportunity to do this at Ghost Ranch, since Richard intends to start training men who have been formally initiated to do the same for others.

Cost: \$385 (includes all food, lodging and round trip transportation from Albuquerque airport to Ghost ranch and back if needed.)
